

DISD Student Referral Flow Chart

CRISIS

Concern of immediate danger of harm *is difficult to determine*

Elementary:
Consult with LPC via phone

Secondary:
LPC will call crisis team as needed

STUDENT OFF CAMPUS?
Any local police officer can be requested to do a "Welfare Check"

Notify guardian;
develop plan of action

Follow up with guardian to ensure resources are in place

Suicidal or Homicidal; **is in immediate danger** of harming self or others

Call **School Police** for **Section 26**

If Section 26 **NOT** necessary, LPC/Counselor assists parents in seeking help for their child

Parents can do a Section 28; or take child to professional; must bring verification of visit when returning to school

NO CRISIS

Mild Behavior
defiant,
angry, peer mediation

Severe
Student has all resources needed;
parent contacted;
resources contacted;
action taken

Counselors

Brief behavior modification/redirection;
and/or connect with MOU/outside agency

Student needs screening

Need parental permission for assessment

If behavior intensifies:
and/or threat of harm to self/others

Contact an LPC

CRISIS INTERVENTION;
Psychosocial assessment provided; recommendations made; follow Up
